#### FIRST STEPS OUTREACH

Jo, Pete and Molly have just completed a 6 week long session of circus skills with the Montessori class, with activities including games, plates, floor rope, balance beams and flower sticks. Each week, accompanied by 3 creche workers, the young performers were



encouraged to explore the various skills available in their own time, and clearly had a great time doing so week after week. They developed their balance, their confidence, their skills, their patience, working as a team, and most importantly, having fun doing so. We're looking forward to seeing how we can develop this aspect of our club further in the future.



#### WIRE WALKING PRACTICE | WEDNESDAYS

You may have spotted a team of wire-walkers practicing on the Village Green on Wednesdays in May and June. While they are only 3 feet off the ground, they are still incredibly rewarding to develop balance and agility. And then, of course, learning tricks! We plan to run another session of wirewalking practice later in the year, and for those who are really interested, you can showcase your skills in our 'Wire and Light' performance piece in November.

#### WIRE WALKING CPD WITH BRUNO

On 27th April we were delighted to welcome Bruno Frenette from the European Centre of Funambulism to Cloughjordan. He ran a day of training for our resident wire-walking instructors - namely Jo, Molly, Pete, Richard and Marketa - to share even more tips and advice on instructing this skill. This was followed by an Open Day of wire-walking where 22 people came along to strut their stuff along a 16mm wide length of wire.

Our instructors will undergo further training later in the year so we can consistently maintain our high standards, and Bruno will help us design and develop the "Wire and Light" performance mentioned above.
